

APOSHO36 Call for Abstract Guidelines

Student Stream

The 36th annual Asia Pacific Occupational Safety & Health Organisation Conference will be held from the 23rd to 25th November 2022 at the Melbourne Convention & Exhibition Centre. APOSHO36 is being hosted by the NSCA Foundation, Australia's leading not for profit, member-based association with a vision focused on helping organisations protect your most important asset — your people.

APOSHO 36 will welcome delegates from across the Asia Pacific region and the world for three days of networking and best practice work, health and safety. The conference theme is *Educate, Enhance, Evolve* and we look forward to welcoming abstracts from higher education students that help to:

- Educate delegates with best practice work/occupational health and safety;
- Enhance delegates knowledge to take back to their workplaces; and
- Evolve delegates outlook through new ideas.

Call for Abstract Process

Abstracts must be submitted through the abstract submission portal. Topics considered should come under the following subjects, but areas outside of this and of interest to WHS/OHS professionals will be considered:

- Mental Health
- Technical
- Wellness
- Innovation
- Occupational Hygienist
- Post COVID World/New Normal
- Technology
- Soft Skills
- OSH Management System/Risk Assessment
- Safety and Health Education

Following the Call for Abstract Deadline, all abstracts will be reviewed by the program committee who will take into account the following criteria:

- Interest to WHS professionals;
- The knowledge displayed in the abstract;
- New Information that will be shared with delegates.

Following the review period all abstracts will be notified via email as to the status of their abstract.





Submission Instructions

- Whilst you can come back to your submission/s at any time (before the submission deadline ends), once you have finished entering all details, please ensure you proceed all the way to the end to COMPLETE your submission. Otherwise, your abstract will not be reviewed.
- Amendments can be made to your abstract until the submission deadline. Simply log into your Currinda profile, select the abstract to amend and navigate through the top tabs to the sections you wish to change.
- An automatic acknowledgement email will be sent once your abstract submission is complete.
- Please note that the title must not be written in all caps, but in sentence case only.

Guidelines

Abstracts must meet the following guidelines to be considered:

- Abstracts must be submitted in English
- Submitted in Word or PDF
- Should be in Arial 12 size font
- The abstract should be no more than 500 words
- The abstract document should include the following:
 - Title of proposed presentation
 - Abstract of proposed presentation with careful considering of how it will Educate, Enhance and Evolve the knowledge of delegates
 - o Full name, job title and organisation of proposed presenter/s
 - o Headshot photograph of proposed presenter/s
 - Bio of proposed presenter/s
- Presentations will be made in English
- Presentation options will be as follows:
 - In person presentation at APOSHO 36, for a total of 8 minutes, this allows a one minute introduction by the chair and one minute for wrap up.
 - Digital Poster Presentation
- Presenters must provide proof of current enrolment into a Bachelor's degree or higher by a recognised Educational Institution.





Prizes

Judging will occur at the APOSHO 36 Conference by both a panel of judges and by conference delegates. The following prizes will be awarded.

- Best In-Person Presentation (Judging Panel and Popular vote)
- Best Poster (Judging Panel and Popular vote)
